

The Afghan Relocation and Assistance Policy (ARAP) – Op Lazurite

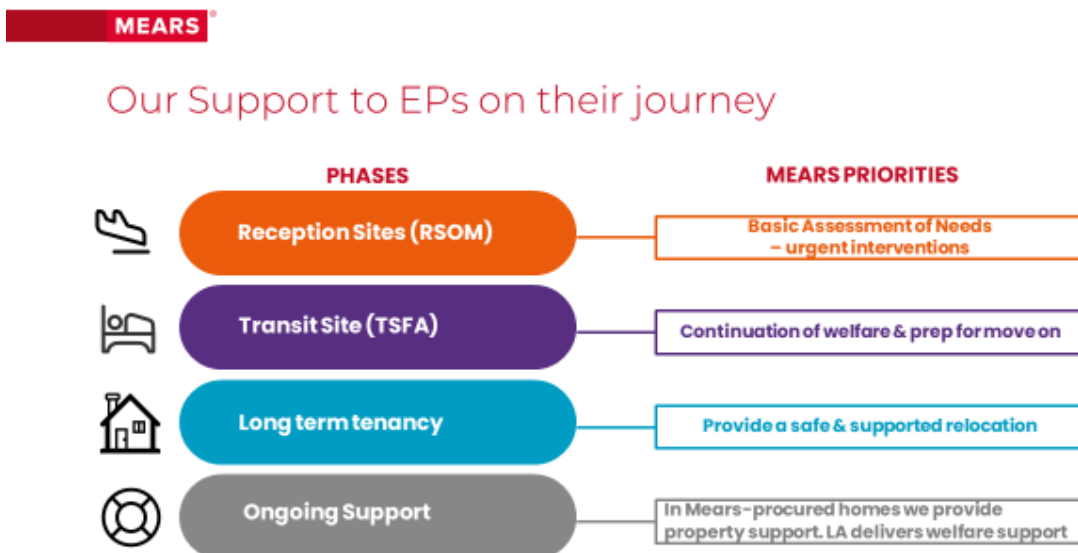
The Afghan Relocation and Assistance Policy (ARAP) Scheme is a safe and legal migration pathway into the UK for Afghan citizens. It is an evidence-based scheme and is intended for a select group who worked for or with the UK Armed Forces in Afghanistan in close and meaningful roles. Afghan citizens who are eligible for relocation to the UK under ARAP may relocate with a partner, dependent children and additional family members who are deemed eligible by the Ministry of Defence, and suitable for relocation by the Home Office following security vetting. Those who are eligible under ARAP are given 'indefinite leave to remain' meaning they have the right to live, work and study in the UK indefinitely.

The meeting held at Beckingham Village Hall, which was well attended, explained to local residents the involvement of the military personnel and civilian support contractors that will oversee the role of Beckingham Training Camp as Reception, Staging and Onward Movement Site for the Afghan families. They will spend some 4 to 6 weeks at the site before they are relocated into Transitional Accommodation and then onto Settled Accommodation on a 3 year lease. The use of Beckingham Camp as a Reception Centre will last for 6 to 12 months but no end date can be confirmed at this time.

The role of a Reception Camp such as Beckingham is to introduce the Afghan families to life in the UK. To help with this the MEARS Company have been contracted by the government to provide the following support for Eps on their journey
